8. Databases

Electronic databases are accessible through the library's web page. Here is a listing of databases to begin with:

ABI/INFORM Archive - NCLive

Digital archive for historically respected business journals. This database includes information on marketing, accounting, management, advertising, ethics, strategies, and more. It also includes the actual image of the complete article from title runs first issue through 1985.

ABI/INFORM Global - NCLive

ABI/Inform Global is a premiere source of business, industry, company, and management information. Provides indexing and abstracts for over 1300 journals. This database includes articles from over 1000 journals from 1986.

Academic Search Elite - NCLive

Provides abstracts and indexing for over 3,200 journals covering a variety of subject areas from 1984 to present

Business Source Elite - NCLive

Provides abstracts and indexing for over 1800 business magazines and periodicals from 1984 to present. Includes many complete articles from more than 1100 business periodicals.

Datamonitor

Provides quality data, expert analysis, and trend predictions for over 10,000 companies, 2000 industries, and 50 countries.

EconLit

EconLit provides citations for articles from journals, books, and working papers as well as dissertations on economics. Look for the NC A&T symbol for titles owned in print.

Emerald Library Fulltext

Emerald publishes over 150 full-text journals including areas of management, library, and information services and a strong specialist range of food science, engineering, applied science and technology journals.

Ethnic NewsWatch

An interdisciplinary, bilingual (English and Spanish) and comprehensive full text database of newspapers, magazines and journals from ethnic, minority and native presses. Linking the current database (1990-present) with a retrospective backfile of titles (1960-1989), the collective coverage spans more than four decades, from 1960 to the present.

Hoover's Company Records - NCLive

Find up to date proprietary editorial content covering more than 40,000 public and non-public companies and 225,000 key executives. Hoover's, widely recognized as a leading provider of corporate data, delivers in depth industry analyses, information on a company's location, summary financials, top competitors, top officers, and more.

InfoTrac Onefile - NCLive

Info Trac OneFile includes over 8,600 titles indexed from 1980 to present; over 5,000 full-text titles.

Ingenta

Provides access to bibliographic citation searching in over 26,000 publications and links to electronic full-text titles owned by A&T.

Jstor

The JSTOR database is unique because the complete archives of over 320 core scholarly journals have been digitized, starting with the very first issues, many of which date from the 1800s. Current issues are not included, but historical journals in the humanities, social sciences, and sciences are available in full text.

Kiplinger Finance & Forecasts

A continuously updated, fully searchable database of over 30 Kiplinger personal finance business publications, this tool gives users the advance notice they need to protect their personal finance and business interests, or answer questions about the outlook for business and the economy.

LexisNexis Academic

Provides access to a wide range of news, business, legal, and reference information. Look under the ***Business*** file and the ***Industry & Market*** subfiles. Over 1 billion articles, cases, and legislation are included in the entire database.

Mergent Online

Mergent Online includes a fully searchable database of 15,000 U.S. public companies. Each company report incorporates up-to-the-minute news items. It also includes access to Wall Street consensus earnings estimates on all companies in the database followed by at least one Wall Street analyst, and provides access to past and current EDGAR® filings.

NBER Working Papers Series

National Bureau of Economic Research is a private, nonprofit, nonpartisan research organization dedicated to promoting a greater understanding of how the economy works. NBER working papers back to November 1994, numbers 4935 and higher, are available.

Risk Abstracts

Risk Abstracts encompasses risk arising from industrial, technological, environmental, and other sources, with an emphasis on assessment and management of risk.

Science Direct

While Science Direct is focused mainly on science, medicine, and technical information, it also includes social sciences and some humanities scholarly journals.

Standard & Poor's Net Advantage

NetAdvantage provides access to a variety of Standard and Poor's information, including Industry surveys, market outlook, stock and bond guides, and other investment information.

Value Line Investment Survey

The service includes full-page reports and analyst commentaries as well as Timeliness™ and Safety™ ranks on more than 1,700 stocks covered by The Value Line Investment Survey.

Wall Street Journal

An index of articles from 1981 to present, through ProQuest Newspapers, this includes many complete articles from 1984 to present.

Web of Science

A multidisciplinary database covering the journal literature of all the sciences; it indexes more than 9,000 major journals across 164 research disciplines. It is the only database offering cited reference searching. It is the electronic equivalent of the Social Sciences Citation Index, the Science Citation Index, and the Arts & Humanities Citation Index. Articles are indexed from 1989 to the present, but cited reference searching is not limited by year.

Wilson Business Full-Text

This database includes leading business magazines, trade and research journals, and the full text of selected periodicals. Full text coverage begins in January 1995. Subjects covered include accounting, economics, finance, human resources, management, marketing, occupational health & safety, and transportation.

WorldCat - OCLC FirstSearch – NCLive

A union catalog of materials held in libraries worldwide, WorldCat lets you determine which libraries may own an item of interest. WorldCat does not indicate, directly, the availability of an item, only whether it is owned. In some cases, you may click on the name of the institution to check that library's online catalog for availability.
