Provides indexing and abstracts for over 1300 business and management journals from 1971 to present.

Academic Search Elite (via EBSCOhost on NCLIVE)

This database provides abstracts and indexing for more than 3,200 scholarly journals. Covers a wide variety of subject areas from 1984 to present.

Business Source Elite (via EBSCOhost on NCLIVE)

Provides abstracts and indexing for over 1500 business magazines and periodicals from 1984 to present, including The Wall Street Journal.

Country Watch

Country-specific geopolitical, social, and economic intelligence on each of the 192 countries of the world.

Datamonitor Business Information Center

Includes information on 10,000 companies, 2,000 industries, and 50 countries. This database includes analyses of various international industries.

EconLit

Journals, books, and working papers on economics.

Emerald Library Fulltext (via MCB) Provides 35,000 full-text articles from over 100 management journals, archived back to 1994.

InfoTrac Onefile (via Gale Info Trac on NCLIVE)

Provides access to 20 million articles in over 6,325 titles indexed from 1980 to present with nearly 3,000 full-text titles

PAIS International and PAIS Archive

Current and retrospective databases chronicling global public policy and social issues.
