Article Indexes

Look for articles on your topic in an index. **You must be a registered library borrower with [library](#) privileges to access the electronic indexes and databases from off-campus. All web databases can be access from anywhere on campus.**

- [Academic Search Premier](#) via EBSCOhost
Provides abstracts and indexing for over 8,200 scholarly journals covering a wide variety of subject areas from 1984 to present. Includes many complete articles from over 4,600 journals, including 3,600 peer reviewed journals dating back to 1990. Over 100 journals contain PDF backfiles to at least 1095 and some back further.
- [Education Full-Text](#) via Wilson Web
This database is the electronic equivalent of the internationally known *Education Index*. Indexing coverage includes education related books since 1995, article abstracting coverage begins with 1994, and full-text coverage begins in 1996. In addition to all forms of education and instruction, subjects covered include athletics, language arts, library science, literacy, school administration, teacher evaluation, and teaching methods.
- [InfoTrac Onefile](#) (GaleNet) (1980-present).
An index to over 2500 journals and magazines covering a variety of topic areas including psychology. Abstracts and sometimes the full-text of articles.
- [Mental Measurements Yearbook](#)
Mental Measurements Yearbook, produced by the Buros Institute, contains fulltext information about and reviews of all English-language standardized tests covering educational skills, personality, vocational aptitude, psychology, and related areas as included in the print [Mental Measurements Yearbooks](#) from the 9th edition to the present.
- [PsycArticles](#) (1887 - present)
An index to journals in psychology and related fields, such as sociology, education, and medicine. Provides primarily references and abstracts for articles. Some articles are available full-text or online. There are also references and abstracts for book chapters, dissertations, and conference papers. Use the *Thesaurus of Psychological Index Terms* (located in the library and online in PsycINFO) to locate acceptable psychological terms for your research topic.
- [PsycInfo](#) (1887 - present)
An index to journals in psychology and related fields, such as sociology, education, and medicine. Provides primarily references and abstracts for articles. Some articles are available full-text or online. There are also references and abstracts for book chapters, dissertations, and conference papers. Use the *Thesaurus of Psychological Index Terms* (located in the library and online in PsycINFO) to locate acceptable psychological terms for your research topic.
- [Social Sciences Citation Index](#) via Web of Science
This bibliographic index allows cited reference searching in the social sciences and provides citations and abstracts for more than 1725 journals covering 50 social sciences disciplines. Key features include the unique ability to identify: review articles; high-impact articles; articles with shared references; and articles influenced by a given article.
- [Social Sciences Full-Text](#) via Wilson Web
This database is the electronic equivalent of the internationally known *Social Sciences Index*. Coverage includes includes a wide range of interdisciplinary fields covered in a broad array of social sciences journals. Abstracting begins in 1994 and full-text coverage begins in 1995. Subjects covered include anthropology, area studies, criminal justice, ethics, family studies, gender studies, geography, gerontology, international relations, law, minority studies, planning & public administration, political science, psychology, social work, sociology, and urban studies.

How to find the article in PsycINFO?

1. **In the Bluford Library:** The Journal Title maybe in Print format or Electronic Format. You can start by looking in the Online Catalog, which will identify our print journals and some of our electronic journals. If the article is in print format you need to photocopy the article. NOTE: Journals do not circulate outside the Library.
2. **In electronic databases:** Find out if the full-text of your article is available in another electronic database, such as *Science Direct* or *Academic Search Premier* by searching for the **title of the journal** in the [Electronic Journals](#) link on the Library's Homepage. Link to the database that holds the journal and the year you need. Look up your article by typing in a few words from the **article title**. Print or email.
3. **From another library:** Use [WorldCat](#) to identify the nearest library that owns that journal.
